We'll also be digging into scripture and read about how God showed His power to Elijah. Throughout this lesson, we want kids to know that the God who created the earth and the sky wants to work in our lives too!

As a family, read through Genesis 1:6-10 and 1 Kings 18:41-46

1. What are some things God created in Genesis 1:6-10?
2. Parents, ask your child what "firmament" means, we went over it today!
3. What does creation tell us about God?
4. How did Elijah see God's power in 1 Kings 18?
5. What does it mean for us that we serve a God that can do such amazing things?
6. Do you remember our memory verse? Try reciting Psalms 19:1.

It is easy to forget that our God created everything! Just looking at our world helps us remember that we serve a Creator who is all-powerful and can do some pretty cool stuff! We can walk with confidence knowing that our God is greater than anything else and that there is no power mightier than Him.
