This week we talked about the amazing story of David defeating Goliath!

I Samuel 16:13 tells that when Samuel anointed David as the chosen one for king, the “Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon David from that day forward.” We clearly see that this was true when young David faced the fearsome Goliath, a mighty warrior who just happened to be about 9 feet, 9 inches tall. The coat of armor he wore weighed about 125 pounds and his spear was about 32 pounds. David may well have weighed less than the armor and weapons this guy carried.

Hello from the Mzawa Church staff! This week we continue our series in Genesis by talking about when God created all the vegetations. The law of the harvest is that the seeds you plant are what you will grow. For example, if you plant a watermelon seed, you won't grow an apple, you'll grow a watermelon. This law also applies to our spiritual life. We cannot sow one thing in our lives and expect to grow something else.

As a family, read through Genesis 1:11-13, Genesis 29, and Galatians 6:7

1. What did God create in Genesis 1:11-13?
2. What is the law of the harvest?
3. In Genesis, how did Jacob trick his father? Who ended up tricking Jacob?
4. How does the law of the harvest apply to our spiritual life? How did it come into play with Jacob's life?
5. Try reciting our memory verse: Galatians 6:7

You cannot sow one thing and grow something else; this is a major spiritual principle that runs through scripture. If we plant good seeds in our life, good fruit will be produced. However, if we are putting bad seeds into our life, we start producing bad fruit. Let's make the effort this week to produce the good fruit that God wants in our lives by taking out the bad and planting the good.
