God never ceases to be amazing! King Hezekiah honored God throughout his life.

2 Kings 18:5 says that he trusted in the Lord like no other king ever had. Yet, trouble came to Israel...big trouble! The king of Assyria had wiped out virtually every other king in the region. No one could fight him off. Now He was at the gates of Jerusalem, warning the people that they'd better give up, because none of the other gods of the nations that he had defeated were able to withstand his mighty army!

What are the differences between the God of Israel and the gods of the other nations that had already been defeated by the Assyrians? (Compare 2 Kings 19, verse 15 & verse 18)

What did Hezekiah want God to prove by delivering Israel? (2 Kings 19:19)

The way Hezekiah dealt with this terrifying threat was remarkable! He went directly into the temple and spread the letter from the enemy right out before the Lord. He took his problem to the Lord KNOWING that God would take care of His people! How about your family? Are you facing some difficult things? As a family, write down the things you are concerned about and then, together in prayer, "lay them out" before Him. Then keep your eyes open and watch Him care for you!

It pays to obey and honor the Lord! King Hezekiah is a fine example of how simply doing what God says and honoring Him with our lives guarantees His blessing!
