Of course, Jesus didn't battle him with His fists; instead, He used God's Word to deal with Satan's temptations. We are beginning to enter Jesus' life as an adult and we are already seeing that God had big plans for this baby from Bethlehem!

As a family, read Matthew 4:1-11 and answer the following questions:

1. Who did Jesus encounter in the wilderness?
2. What were the three temptations Satan used against Jesus?
3. How did Jesus fight back?
4. Why do you think Jesus used the Bible to defeat Satan?
5. What can we learn from how Jesus defeated Satan?

2 Timothy 3:16 says that scripture is "God-breathed" and "useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness." Jesus didn't need to use anything but God's Word to rebuke Satan's temptations. Satan tried to attack Jesus when he was at His weakest in the wilderness, but the apostle Paul said it best in 2 Corinthians that when we are weak, we are strong! God's Word is a powerful tool and after reading about how Jesus used it against Satan, it begins to make a lot more sense as to why we need to be in God's Word day and night!
